Beachfront DINING

Whether you're planning a day trip or a week-long stay along the south coast, make some time to visit the area's latest food and wine hotspots.

A new beachfront restaurant is adding a Mediterranean vibe and food style to Port Noarlunga.

The restaurant is owned by husband-and-wife team Filipe and Paula Horta who have worked in hospitality in Adelaide for many years and also run Brighton Jetty Café.

The Hortas won the tender 18 months ago to operate this new restaurant which is right on the

beachfront alongside the jetty at Port Noarlunga.

The restaurant has a lounge area and a large, open dining room surrounded by windows, decking and a balcony with unbeatable jetty and reef views.

The interior feels beachy with walls in neutral Porters paint colours and tables set with comfortable custom-made timber and leather chaise.

The head chef is Nicole Bayley (ex Woodstock Winery) and the menu is partly inspired by Filipe's Portuguese heritage. The a-la-carte menu features a range of petiscos or tapas such as pasteis de bacalhau cod fish cakes or favas com toucinho e

chorizo broad beans with pork belly and chorizo. Main courses include a seafood bouillabaisse, marinated chicken thigh skewers or a Portuguese rabbit stew.

Filipe's wine list includes plenty of SA wines, along with a selection of Portuguese labels.

Horta's has acoustic guitarists playing Friday and Saturday night.

There is also a separate fish and chip kiosk downstairs for more casual dining.
